Brief Overview of the The Children's Day Service

I look up from my books at the little grade two girl running towards my desk. Little Alizwa throws her arms around my neck and cries out as she buries her head in my neck: "Where were you on Monday? I was looking for you". "But you know I'm not at your school on a Monday." "But I needed you then", she cried. Hush now puppet and tell me why you needed me." I lift her onto my lap, wipe her tears but as I try to hug her, she jerks away in pain. On closer inspection, I discover the tiny body covered in bruises. "Who did this to you Alizwa"? The story which unfolded was horrific. I was shocked to the core of my very being.

Day by day the media shares stories of such heinous acts. The statistics do not reflect the true numbers as hundreds of such cases do not get reported. The real truth? Abuse is rife in our communities. We live in a poverty stricken society. How many more Alizwas are there in the wider community? There might even be some in our very own local churches. Yet such kids are at Sunday School, Sunday after Sunday because it poses to be a 'home away from home". Isn't it time such children are identified and the Sunday School or a matter of fact the church in it's entirety reach out to such kids? Those in the community as well as those within the folds of the church ? (CHARITY BEGINS AT HOME) " God is calling us to participate in suffering and struggle". The first Sunday in June is "National Children's Day" on the calendar of UCCSA. The children's ministry of SA Synod started the "Children's Gift" in 2012 to lend a helping hand to those who suffer from abuse, are challenged by poverty, by disabilities and life threatening diseases. Through this project we also wish to bring about an awareness and teach our children to reach out, touch the lives of those suffering and try to make a difference. Today is the second year we distributed these envelopes. The idea wasn't very well received in 2012. The 50% which was allocated to the synod amounted to R25 000- This year we trust that we will receive considerably more so that we can do more and touch more lives and in so doing bring some joy to some suffering children.
